

Operational ACs	 Guilhem gives the following status: 3 ACs are fully operational: GOP, GSFC, CNES/CLS 3 are no longer providing IDS products on a regular basis ESA did not provide series after its contribution to ITRF2014, but did contribute to ITRF2020; will it again deliver series on the expected pace for ACs? IGN: a new team (Arnaud Pollet, Samuel Nahmani) is in place after the retirement of Pascal. They are working with JPL on the implementation of DORIS in Gipsy-X. They will not be able to do any operational production for several months, but progress are encouraging, as reported from a meeting CNES/IGN. INASAN is working on the development of its own software GeoIS dedicated to SLR and DORIS processing. It is still in progress. GFZ provided with single solutions for Jason-1/2/3, Sentinel-3A/B, in the frame of the analysis for ITRF2020. The governing board wishes to have a more complete status of the ESA and INASAN, and know if GFZ could consider operational treatments.
