## **AWG Meeting in Athens**

# 6–7 November 2025 National Technical University of Athens (NTUA) Patision Complex, 42 Patision (28 Oktovriou) Street, 10682 Athens, Greece

## 1. Venue Information

The meeting will take place at the **National Technical University of Athens (NTUA)**, **Patision Complex at** the Historic Rectorate Building.

## 2. Getting from Athens Airport (ATH) to the City Centre (Syntagma / NTUA)

Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" (ATH) is approximately **33 km** east of central Athens. You can reach the city easily by **metro, bus, or taxi**.

#### By Metro

- Take Metro Line 3 (Blue Line) from Airport → Syntagma Station.
- Duration: ~40 minutes.
- Cost: **€9 (one-way)**.
- Frequency: every 30 minutes, from 06:30 to 23:30.

#### **By Airport Bus**

- Take Bus X95 (Airport Syntagma), which runs 24/7.
- Duration: ~50–60 minutes, depending on traffic.
- Cost: **€5.50**.
- Purchase tickets at the kiosk outside the Arrivals area (Door 5).
   The bus stops directly at Syntagma Square, in front of the Hellenic Parliament.

#### By Taxi

- Available 24/7 outside the Arrivals hall.
- Fixed fare to central Athens:
  - €40 (05:00-00:00)
  - €55 (00:00-05:00)
- Duration: ~35 minutes, depending on traffic.

## 3. Reaching NTUA from the City Centre (Syntagma Area)

#### Metro:

Take Line 2 (Red Line) from Syntagma → Omonia Station, then walk about 8 minutes to the NTUA entrance on Patision Street.

#### • Bus / Trolley:

From Syntagma, you can take **Trolley 11** or **Bus 022** and get off at the **"Polytechneio"** stop on Patision Street.

#### Walking:

From **Omonia Square**, the NTUA main gate is about a **10-minute walk** along Patision Street.

#### Taxi:

A short 10-minute ride from central Athens (cost around €5–7).

## 4. Lunch, Coffee & Breaks

Coffee breaks and light lunch will be provided for all participants during both days at the venue.

A variety of cafés, bakeries, and small restaurants are located just outside the university premises for those who wish to explore local options.

## 5. Visit to Dionysos Observatory (Thursday, 6 November)

A **coach organized by NTUA** will depart from the NTUA Patision Complex at **14:00**. The visit will last approximately **3.5 hours**, and the return to NTUA is planned around **18:00**. Please wear comfortable shoes — the visit includes short walking segments.

## 6. Social Dinner (Thursday, 6 November, 20:00)

A social dinner will be organized for all participants at 20:00.

The venue will be announced soon.

Each participant will cover their own expenses.

### 7. Practical Information

- **Weather:** Early November in Athens is mild (18–22°C daytime, 13–15°C evenings). A light jacket is recommended.
- Currency: Euro (€). Most places accept credit/debit cards.
- Language: English is widely spoken.
- Power sockets: Type C and F (European standard, 230V).
- Emergency number: 112 (EU-wide).

## 8. Things to See Nearby

- National Archaeological Museum 5 minutes' walk from NTUA.
- Acropolis and Plaka area 15 minutes by metro from Omonia.
- Monastiraki and Ermou Street ideal for walking, cafés, and souvenirs.
