

- 1. Survey and site reconnaissance at Riyadh completed March 2009.
- 2. Site recon. Completed for Tamanrasset (Algeria).
- 3. Still searching for new station site in Alaska; candidate site is Cold Bay (Fairbanks building housing DORIS slated for demolition in 2010).
- 4. Total 57 beacons; 3 Russian unavailable to be finally replaced soon.
- 5. Beacons version 3.2 to be available by 2010; 200 m cable length.


